

Oratory Trip to Martyrs' Shrine

On 16 March 1649, Saint John de Brebeuf and St Gabriel Lalemant were tortured to death by Iroquois warriors who had destroyed the village of Saint Ignace II and several other Huron settlements. The exact location of Saint Ignace II is now known and there is an outdoor altar set up. On 16 March 2011, we will go by school bus to Saint Ignace II and celebrate Mass there. We will also visit Martyrs' Shrine and several nearby sites that are associated with the Canadian Martyrs. We will leave from Holy Family Church at 8:30 a.m.; we plan to arrive back at Holy Family Church at around 6:30 p.m.

What to bring: Warm clothes -- be prepared to walk through snow or mud and stand outside for the duration of Mass. Packed lunch and snacks -- we will not be stopping for dinner. Permission form.
