## SAINT PAUL THE APOSTLE

Our Holy Father Pope Benedict XVI has designated 2008 as the "Year of Saint Paul," commemorating the 2000th anniversary of his birth. To join in the celebrations, we have made Saint Paul the topic of the second week of summer school.

We'll look at the historical background of Saint Paul, his conversion, his missionary journeys, and his trials and martyrdom, study individual letters written to the Christian Churches, and investigate common Pauline theological themes which arise from those letters, such as the doctrines of original sin, the Mystical Body of Christ, law and grace, and justification.
