His personal influence brought many to the Church and to an appreciation of the need for orthodox belief in a world dominated by liberalism. The truth does not change to fit our tastes.

As with all saints, the true glory is not merely the work they have done, but the triumph of holiness over our own personal challenges. It is a wonder to watch God at work, producing new saints.
