THE PROTESTANT REFORMATION AND THE CATHOLIC RESPONSE

We will look at this complicated affair from a variety of angles (historical, political, theological, and even artistic), drawing on official Church documents as well as the lives of the saints from the period. We will address such enduring topics as the constant need for reform within the Church, the place of Scripture in the Church, the importance of our sacramental life, and the call to a deeper spiritual life, a life dedicated to the pursuit of holiness. These events triggered an outpouring of activity within the Church, a movement called the Counter-Reformation that has helped form the Church for the past five centuries. With a period so complex and interesting, the trouble is not figuring out what to talk about, but deciding what to leave out!
